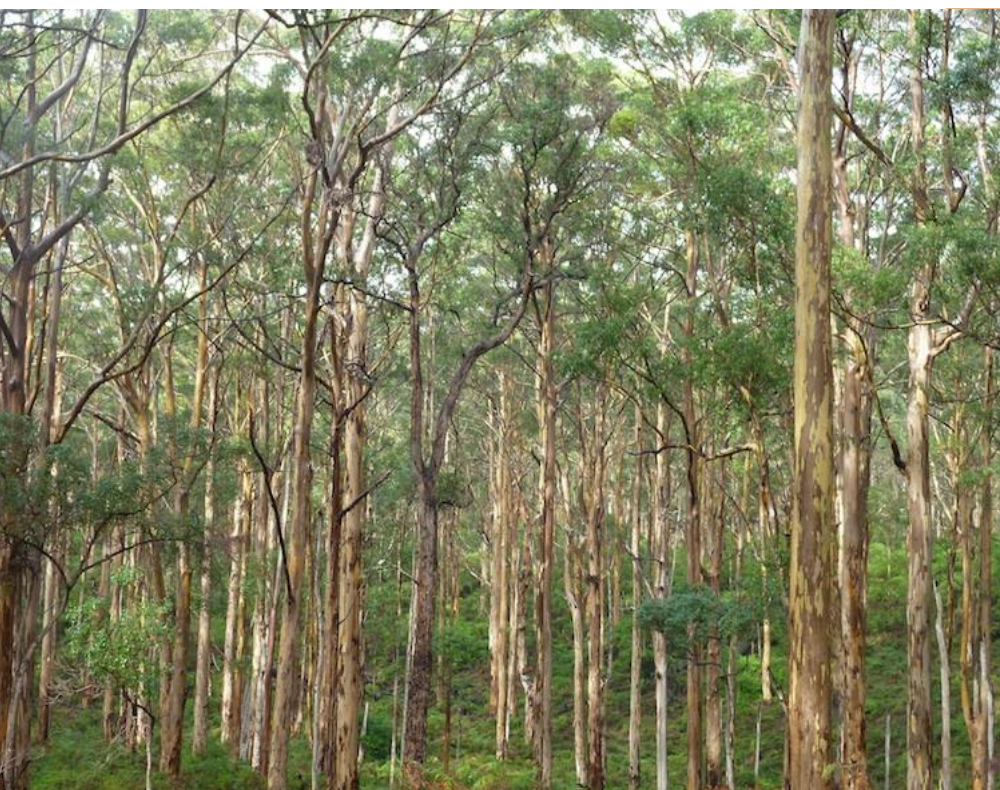




Cape to Cape 3 Day Glamping Experience

Thank you for choosing Cape to Cape Explorer Tours to experience the Margaret River Region. Please read through the following information to ensure you have the best Cape to Cape experience possible.

Duration: 3 days/ 2 nights package



What to Expect

45 days prior to your tour commencing: you will receive an invoice for your final payment. If under 30 days full payment is required on booking.

7-14 days prior to your tour commencing: you will receive a detailed logistics planner – the where, when, and who – via email.

When you arrive: you will check into your beautiful canvas bell tent at Prevelly Camp Ground where you will find your breakfast supplies and fresh salads and BBQ ingredients for your dinner that evening.

Your weekend includes delicious continental breakfasts, enjoying your fantastic Wild Goose Camping setup, relaxing at the beach in Gnarabup and exploring some the highlights of the Cape to Cape Track and Leeuwin Naturaliste National Park.

Our professional, local guides have extensive knowledge and experience interpreting the natural beauty of the Margaret River Region. We've been hiking, surfing, fishing, and foraging in this local environment all our lives – Nobody knows the local spots, local stories, local food and local wildlife better than us!

Itinerary

Day 1: Friday

Arrive in the historic coastal hamlet of Prevelly

Arrive in the afternoon and check into your Wild Goose Camping 5-meter Canvas Bell tent at Prevelly Caravan Park. Pitched and furnished for your convenience, Wild Goose set up and provide everything you need for a unique camping experience. From rugs and doonas, to blankets and seating, your tent will be comfortably furnished you can just relax and enjoy. When dinnertime comes, you will have everything you need to then cook your own BBQ and submerge yourselves in nature and the camping way of life.



Day 2: Saturday

Enjoy a relaxing day and explore the true nature of Margaret River by starlight

Wake up under beautiful cream cotton canvas in luxury and comfort to the sounds of the sea nearby. There's no need to go far, a Continental Breakfast (yogurt, fresh fruit, cereals and high quality breads) will be provided so you can enjoy a relaxing morning settling into the slow pace of campsite life. Enjoy the beach which is only a short walk from your tent.

For lunch you have the choice of heading further afield and indulging at one of the many fantastic wineries or breweries throughout the region. If you would prefer to stay local, the White Elephant Beach Café is only a short stroll from the campsite with delicious options also available from the store if you choose.

At 5pm Cape to Cape Explorer Tours will arrive to collect you from the campsite and take you on the Sunset, Forest and Cave Explorer Tour. You will be spotting wild Western Grey Kangaroo's grazing the plains, marveling at giant Karri tree's in the Boranup Forest, followed with watching the sunset at one of the most stunning vistas on the acclaimed Cape to Cape Track. Dusk in the doline (a collapsed chamber that forms a cave entry) is an enchanted time, with abundant forest birdlife singing out in the giant old growth karris that tower over head.

Participants then have the chance to explore the underground wonderland beneath the Boranup Forest via torch light with helmet provided, while learning about the unique history and geology of an amazing limestone cave famous for its enormous wide open chambers and adventure sections.

Dinner will then be provided by Cape to Cape Explorer Tours with yummy soup and bread rolls from a local bakery served under the stars.

Day 3: Sunday

Hike to Cape Mentelle and learn about local history

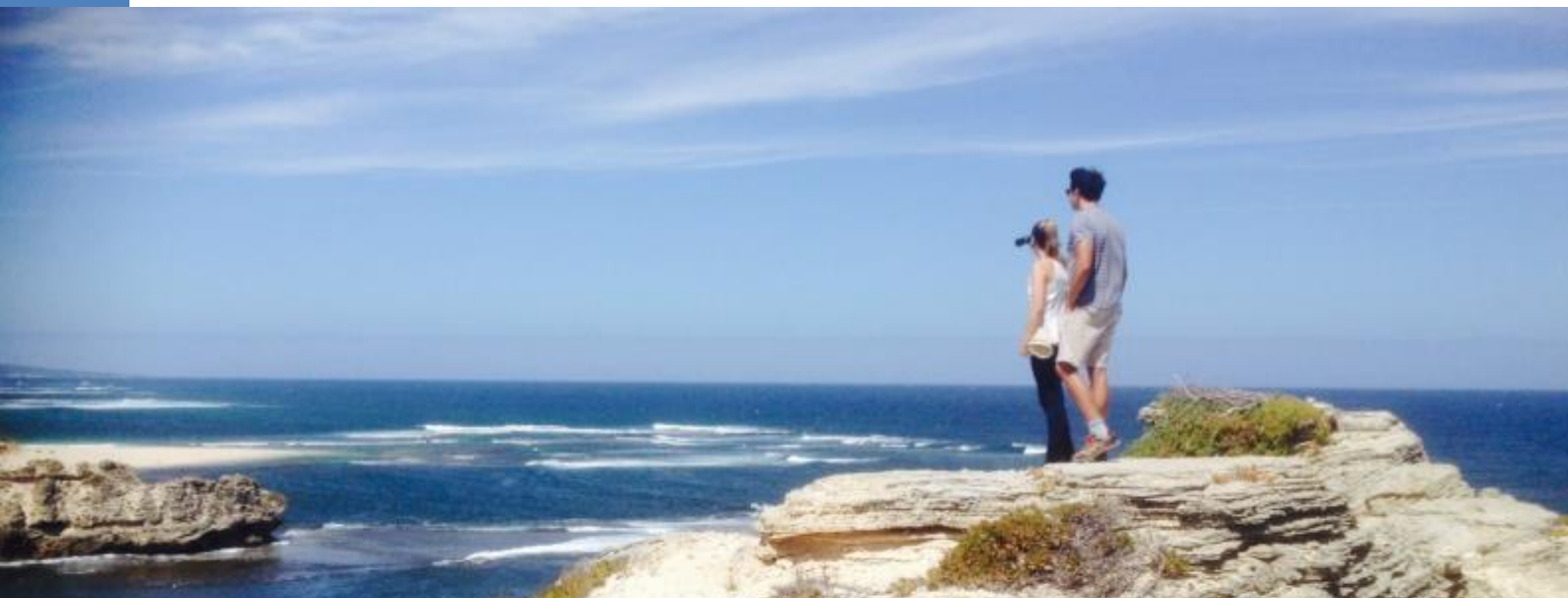
Wake up with the knowledge that more adventures lie ahead. But first you might choose to pop down to the beach for a quick dip! After another delicious breakfast at camp, check out from your Wild Goose Bell Tent. All you will need to do is collect your personal belongings and zip up the tent on the way out. At 10am, your next Cape to Cape Explorers begins:

An east hike out to the beautiful Cape Mentelle followed by a snorkel checking out the abundant marine life. Next learn about Nicolas Baudin's journey from France to Western Australia in 1800, that led to the naming of Cape Mentelle. Learn of the interesting and surprising link between this magnificent headland and the history of these French explorers. Also learn about CCET director Gene Hardy's surf sessions with Cape Mentelle and Cloudy Bay founder David Hohnen out at Margaret River Mainbreak when Dave spoke of ducking off to NZ to plant a few vines.



Package Includes:

- 2 nights accommodation in spacious canvas bell tents pitched and furnished for you at Prevelly Caravan Park.
- Daily continental style breakfast with cereal, toast, fruit, yoghurt, tea & coffee.
- Delicious fresh and healthy salads with local produce for you to cook your own BBQ at the campsite on your first night.
- The opportunity for you to explore the Margaret River Region and find a quaint winery or relaxed brewery for lunch on both days throughout the weekend. Alternatively, the White Elephant Beach Cafe is just a short stroll along the beach and has a fantastic menu (own cost).
- Sunset, Forest and Cave Explorer Tour, including a delicious meal of hearty soup served with fresh local bakery rolls under the stars.
- Private guided walk to the magnificent Cape Mentelle to learn more about the history of this incredible region.
